PCCL cases:

- Involve common pediatric acute care scenarios.
- Highlight challenges in diagnosis, assessment or management.
- May highlight challenges related to location or local resources.
- Will include de-identification of the case.
- Address learning objectives determined by the team who presents the case.

What - A de-identified case presented by providers from a range of communities across BC

How - The PICU team at BCCH will facilitate the interactive discussion
